Together SA is a for-purpose, member-based social enterprise, leading the Collective Impact movement for social change in South Australia. We exist because strong evidence tells us that the current social system is inadequate for our most disadvantaged communities, despite significant resourcing and considerable effort.

Together SA was established in July 2013 by a unique alliance of cross-sector partners with an aspirational and ambitious vision for how we can work together to collectively achieve better outcomes with and for South Australian communities.

In just 5 years, 13 Collective Impact initiatives have emerged in our state, as part of a maturing network of Collective Impact communities Australia-wide. This growing movement for social change is challenging the status quo in a 'whole-of-community' response to large scale social problems.

At Together SA, our vision is that South Australians work together to achieve positive and measurable social change through Collective Impact. So, what does this mean?

- Community driven problem definition and solution creation
- Deep partnerships focused on a common agenda
- Cross-sector alignment to strengthen and sustain impact
- System change for better outcomes with and for communities
